Bad Credit Announces U.S. Tour

Boston—12 NOV 2023 — Following up on the success of their latest album Through

The Corridor, the eclectic collective of some of the brightest up-and-coming musicians will take
on America in their first national tour.

Their tour will start at their current base of operations at Brighton Music Hall in Boston, and move south as they take the eastern seaboard. From Atlanta they'll move out west, where they'll move northeast across the plains, and back towards New England for a three-night run of shows at NuBlu in Brooklyn, NY.

Through The Corridor, released in July 2023, struck gold in the online world after a video of Stevie Wonder, Stevie Nix, and Steve-O reacting to the song "Send Your Love." As listeners discovered the album, it soon became a best-seller. While "Orange" became viral after a series of TikTok remixes, it was the title track that found the most success, sitting on top of the Billboard Hot 100 for three weeks. Combined with a string of dates opening for John Mayer and Knower, the demand for live shows grew until a major tour was the obvious next step.

Bad Credit came together after guitarist Fletcher Medler graduated from Berklee College of Music in Boston, Massachusetts. Pulling from the music scene, he put together a collective consisting of drummers Matt Smith and Milton Stewart, singer and producer Susan Platt, Sam Smith on the bass, and the 2013 Downbeat Magazine award winner of Best Steel Guitarist, Bradley Emmett. After becoming locally known for their high-energy shows they recorded and produced their first album on their own. As Bad Credit embarks on their first tour, their prospects only seem increasingly bright.
